First Reading | Exodus 34: 4B-6, 8-9

Early in the morning Moses went up Mount Sinai as the LORD had commanded him, taking along the two stone tablets. Having come down in a cloud, the LORD stood with Moses there and proclaimed his name, "LORD." I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son,


who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.
