- 1 small, handheld pencil sharpener
- 1 package of 4 dry erase markers
- 1 set of watercolor markers (Art-assortment of 12 or less)

### **5<sup>th</sup> Grade**

**Every student needs the following for the entire school year:**

*\*Please note that sharing of supplies will not be allowed when we return to the building. Student's full name must be written on each item for identification.*
