



E-Learning for 4-28-20

1. Religion

Topic: Seeds for 4-26-20 (Jesus' friends know him.)

Objectives: Your child will

- Hear how Jesus' friends recognized him when he broke and shared bread with them.

Materials/Resources: Seeds booklet for 4-26-20, Bible, Seeds Handbook page 33, crayons and Coloring sheet from <http://catholicmom.com/wp-content/uploads/2020/04/3EasterA.pdf>.

Activities:

Pray: "I love you dear Jesus, I offer today, All that I think and do and say."
"Amen."

Retell Sunday's Gospel. Have your child look at page 1 of Seeds booklet. Show that Jesus is breaking the bread to share with his friends. Tell this reminds us of what Jesus did at the Last Supper.

Your child may color page form CatholicMom.

2. Language Arts

Topic:

HEA children: Rhyming

Others: Letter Yy

Objectives: Your child will be able to

(Happily Ever After)

- Recognize rhyme
- Identify rhyming words

(Others)

- Identify letter Yy
- Follow directions
- Listen to story
- With help retell story

Materials/resources:

(HEA children) Pages 54 and 55—Happily Ever After, Unit 10 Lesson 2; crayons

(Others) <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=RJH2oMKPeaw>

crayons, one of the Letter Y worksheets—your choice.

Activity:

HEA:

Have your child select a pick crayon and trace fish and dish on page 54. Remind your child that fish and dish are rhyming words because both words end with the same sound. Do the same with page 55.

Practice finding rhyming words for star, tree, hat, sock.

Others: Let your child pick out a story for you to read. Help your child retell the story.

Watch ABC/letter Y video, complete a letter Y worksheet from mailing—your choice.

3. Math, Science, Social Studies

Topic: Farms

Objectives: Child will be able to

- Understand there are different kinds of farms
- Tell some foods that are grown on a crop farm

Materials/resources: video: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=iJt-dLb6djQ>

work sheet from packet—"Crop Farms", crayons, grocery store ads.

Activity: Show crop farm video, discuss. Your child may complete crop farm page, drawing vegetables on shelves or gluing pictures cut from store ads!

5. Fine Arts:

Topic: Music, dance, imaginative play, crafts

Objectives: Your child will be able to

- Participate in dance, movement, song
- Use imagination while playing house(cooking, cleaning, caring for dolls.) or other.
- Create using various art materials

Materials: Music, Google "youtube Jack Hartman preschool songs/dance/exercise", Google "preschool youtube Super Simple Songs," dressup clothes, play food,(you can save empty food boxes/containers)dishes, etc., other toys, craft materials, animal work sheets

Activity: Turn up the music in your home for a while. You can go to you tube or use your own CD's.

Provide materials and area for imaginative play. Examples can be playing house, doing construction, or imagining about a storybook.

Your child may color, cut out, glue animal(s) to worksheet with barn that he/she colored yesterday. This can be a several day project. Adding another animal each day.
