### 1. Religion

Topic: Seeds for 4-26-20 (Jesus' friends know him.)

Objectives: Your child will

Letter Y worksheet from packet—your choice, crayons and/or playdough/clay

Activity:

HEA:

Watch ending sounds video.

Ask child to name the pictures in the first box on page 1. (sink, stove) Ask why they might be grouped together. (They both belong in a house or kitchen.)

Repeat these questions with the rest of the page, discussing how the items in each box relate to each other.

Looking at the pictures in the first box again, have your child name each item and its color. (pink sink, pink stove)

Ask which picture's name rhymes with its color. (pink sink)

Tell your child to underline the pink sink with pencil to show that its name rhymes with its color. Repeat and complete rest of the page.

#### Others:

Watch ABC video, complete a letter Y worksheet from mailing—your choice.

Make y's out of playdough/clay.

### 3. Math, science, Social Studies

Topic: Farms

Objectives: Child will be able to

- Name things horses eat
- Name how horses are cared for

Materials/resources: video about horses--
