



E-Learning for 5-13-20

1. Religion

Topic: We belong to the Church

Objectives: Your child will

- recognize Jesus as our leader.
- recognize the priest as the leader of our parish community

Materials/Resources: What the Church Believes and Teaches (page 10), crayons

Activity:

Have your child pray preschool's morning prayer: "I love you dear Jesus, I offer today, all that I think and do and say."

Review: We are followers of Jesus. Jesus is our leader. When Jesus went up to Heaven after rising from the dead, He left his friend Peter in charge of all of His followers here on Earth. Today we have Pope Francis as head of all Jesus' followers around the world. In our parish, the pastor is our leader.

Our priests are Father George and Father Mike.

They lead us when we go to church for Mass. They wear special clothes. They are leaders of our parish family—that's why we call them *Father*.

Discuss page 10 and have your child complete it.

Find Mary's picture in Handbook and pray the Hail Mary.

Objectives: Your child will be able to

Activity:

HEA: Play Jack Hartmann videos,

Have your child cut out the pictures on activity page 61 to make 20 picture cards. Spread the cards on a table and ask your child to identify each picture by name. Have your child pick up a card, name picture and find another that rhymes with it. Then match two others that rhyme. Continue until all are matched.

Others:

Watch video and sing along. Have your child trace the bubbles on the activity sheet. Ask what letter the bubbles look like.

Have your child finish coloring page. Then look around the house for other things that look like letter Oo.
