



E-Learning for 5-4-20

1. Religion

Topic: Seeds for 5-3-20 (Jesus is our shepherd.)

Objectives: Your child will

- Identify how pets are cared for

Materials/Resources: Seeds booklet for 5-3-20, crayons emailed Hail Mary coloring page.

Activity:

Pray: "Jesus, you love us as a shepherd loves his sheep. You take care of us as a good shepherd does. Thank you, Jesus!" All Pray, Amen."

Ask: Who cares you at home? How do they care for you? What or who do you care for? Discuss pets. If your child doesn't have any, ask how people care for pets?

Look at page 2 in Seeds. Discuss pictures and graph. Help your child color in pet pictures according to how many you have in your home.

Tomorrow you will continue lesson by reading Gospel about the Good Shepherd.

2. Language Arts

Topic:

HEA children: Practice with shapes and following an arrow

Others: Letter Zz

Objectives: Your child will be able to

(Happily Ever After)

- Identify colors: red, blue, yellow, purple
- Identify shapes: circle, square, rectangle, arrow, triangle
- Follow oral directions
- Trace shapes
- Color in

(Others) If you still have letter Yy pages, you can practice one more day. and start Zz tomorrow.

- Identify letter Zz
- Follow directions
- Listen to story
- With help, retell story

Activity:

HEA: Have your child name the shape in each box. Say that you will give hints about shapes. When he/she knows the shape, he/she should name it and point to it.

Hints:

All four sides are the same length.

It has no corners because it is round.

This is the only shape with three sides.

Two sides are long and two are short.

Have your child trace each shape with pencil, starting at dot and following the arrow. Then have your child draw his/her own shapes.

Give these directions on coloring in the shapes:

Color in the first circle with your blue crayon.

Color in the first triangle with red crayon.

Color in the first square with yellow crayon.

Color in the first rectangle with your purple crayon.

Your child should then go back coloring the second shapes to match the first ones.

Watch shape practice video.

Others:

Watch Letter Z video. Discuss. Color in letter Z and Zebra.

3. Math, science, Social Studies

Finish any farm activity worksheets you have today.

If your child is finished, he/she may draw a picture about a farm (animal, building, equipment, etc.) in his/her journal...then dictate something for you to write.

4. Fine Arts/Social Studies

Topic: Family traditions (Religious)

Objectives: Your child will

- Recognize Mary as Jesus' mother
- Practice, with help, Hail Mary
- Understand that we honor Mary, especially during month of May

Materials/resources: emailed Hail Mary coloring page.

We honor Mary during the month of May. We will have some special activities this week.

Today your child may color and trace coloring page and display in your home.

(Hail Mary coloring page was emailed for you to print.)
