



## E-Learning for 5-6-20

### 1. Religion

Topic: Seeds for 5-3-20 (Jesus is our shepherd.)

Objectives: Your child will

- Retell the story of the good shepherd

Materials/Resources: Seeds booklet for 5-3-20, crayons, scissors, tape

Activity:

Have your child turn to page 3 and find the shepherd with his arms up. Tell he is looking for one of his sheep. Direct your child to put a finger on the shepherd and follow the path to the sheep. Then use crayon.

Help your child cutout the shepherds and two sheep on page 4. Tape shepherd so that it stands. Sheep can just be folded on dotted lines. Help print name of your child on one sheep and name of friend or family member on the other.

Show how to place the sheep in the pen on the cover of Seeds. Show how shepherd fits in the open gate to keep sheep safe.

Pray: "We gather in Jesus' name. Jesus is our shepherd. We are his sheep. Jesus protects us and keeps us safe."

Have your child place sheep in pen on cover of Seeds.

Say: " Thank you for being my shepherd, Jesus." Place Jesus, the Good Shepherd, in the entrance and say: "Jesus is our shepherd. Let us listen to his voice." All say "Amen."

## 2. Language Arts

Topic:

HEA children: Practice with triangles, sequencing

Others: Letter Zz

Objectives: Your child will be able to

(Happily Ever After)

- Identify triangles, red, blue, yellow
- Follow oral directions
- Sequence events
- Match pictures
- Use crayon, scissors, glue
- Retell simple stories

(Others)

- Identify letter Zz
- Follow directions

Materials/resources:

(HEA) Activity Page 5-6, crayons (red, blue, yellow), glue, rhyming practice video-<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=RVophT8naUM>

Others) Letter Z video , 2 page worksheets for Letter z puzzle, crayons, scissors, glue

Activity:

HEA: Using page 5, remind your child that triangles can look very different from one another, but as long as a shape has three sides, it's a triangle.

Have your child match each triangle on the left to matching triangle on right and color matching triangle the same color.

Using page 6, point out cutting lines (dotted lines), and have your child cut out the boxes. Have your child glue them on the left in sequence. Do one row at a time while discussing what is happening next in each story.

When complete, ask your child retell each story.

### 3. Science

Topic: Washing hands

Objectives: Your child will be able to

- Understand importance of washing hands

Materials/Resources: Video

### 4. Fine Arts/Social Studies

Topic: Using crayons, religious tradition

Objectives: Your child will be able to

- Fill in using crayons
- Understand we celebrate Mary, during month of May

Materials/Resources: [printable coloring page sent in email](#), crayons

Activity: Have your child color picture of Mary. Cut it out for your child and tape or staple bottom part to make ring for standing. (You can make crown by having your child color the little flowers at the top of the page and glue on Mary's head.)

More ideas—make indoor May altar with paper Mary statue and flowers/ or make outside Mary garden in a sheltered place—maybe on a covered porch with potted plant.
