| Principal Report | Dave | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Concerts – Band concert that we were supposed to host is cancelled due to a problem with PoP’s schedule. Christmas concert is on for this year December 16th (change in date from Dec 9). Nicole is possibly looking into starting a school choir. Just in the beginning stages. • COVID Update – Very low numbers, this is a good thing • Faith Formation – Set for Sat April 23 (Confirmation), still waiting on 1st communion and reconciliation Upper grades will be participating virtually with the Holy Fire program this Friday. School is trying to expose students to Catholic Vocations that are out there. • Legislative Requirements and New Requirements – Schools must allow students to modify the uniform for modesty according to religion. The legislation seems to refer to head coverings and under shirts/leggings under uniforms. Law enforcement drill requires schools to notify parents and have an “opt out”. Our law enforcement drill is tomorrow. In Spring there are plans to have a simulated flight in the event of an intruder. Office staff is looking at options for a safe center and updating the current plan as well as rendezvous points. In addition to providing information about tobacco products, they also need to provide information about vape/e-cigs. Schools cannot prohibit hair styles that are related to culture. • Parent-Teacher Conferences – Virtual – the link will be sent out soon. • School Safety Drills (see above) • Student Council – This is on Friday, volunteers have been secured • Tax Credit Scholarships (TCS) – comes into effect in Dec. The 2 for 1 match incentive will be offered again. We have 43 students receiving scholarships, we have an additional 41 on the wait list. Will the registration incentive come into play? Will there be a minimum? Perhaps a \$500 min donation gets you your \$150 registration fee for free. | | |
