

Welcome to 2nd Grade

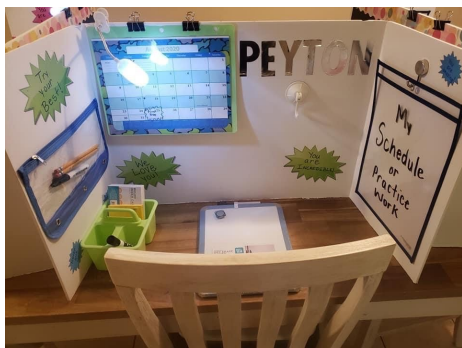
