For your summer work in ELA, select one item **from each row**. **Two assignments** must be completed and submitted to your teacher by the end of the first week of school.

You may select your own book, but the book should be at a reading level for grades 5-7. For those students who have not yet joined Google Classroom, the Class Code is p4wh4nj.

<p>Row 1 (Select one task from this row)</p>	<p>Select a book to read at your reading level and read it. Pretend you are a talk show host. Interview one or more characters. Write at least 10 questions and answers. This should be written in dialogue or transcript format. The questions and answers should provide information that shows you have read the book.</p>	<p>Select a book to read at your reading level and read it. Create a picture book version of the story that would appeal to younger students.</p>	<p>Select a book to read at your reading level and read it. Create a Book in a Bag using a large paper bag.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. On the front of the bag draw a scene from the book. <u>Computer images are NOT permitted.</u> 2. On the back of the bag write a one page summary of the book. 3. Inside the bag place five items that show something from the book. Each item should have an explanation card that explains why the item represents something from the book.
<p>Row 2 (Select one task from this row)</p>	<p>Select a book to read at your reading level and read it. Write a new ending for the book. The new ending should be several paragraphs in length.</p>	<p>Select a book to read at your reading level and read it. Then, write a book report that includes the title, author, a brief summary of the book, information about the main character(s), conflict, and main events of the book.</p>	<p>Select a book to read at your reading level and read it. Create a three panel Novel Brochure.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Novel Title and Author must be on the front cover. 2. The inside of the brochure must include the following subheadings: Introduction, Summary, Characters, Theme, Favorite Quotes, Analysis, and Rating. <u>Refer fo the sample format attached.</u>
