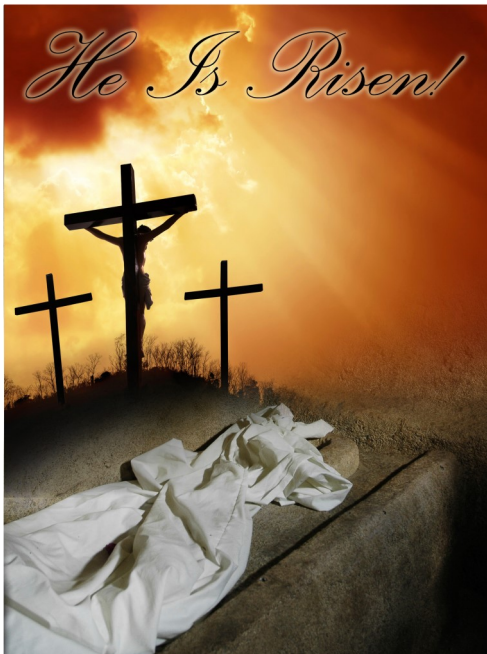

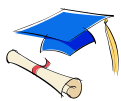
VBS Day Camp 2020 cancelled.

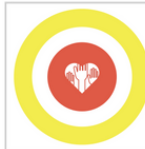
Congratulations to all who graduate from college this spring! We wish you many blessings in the future.
