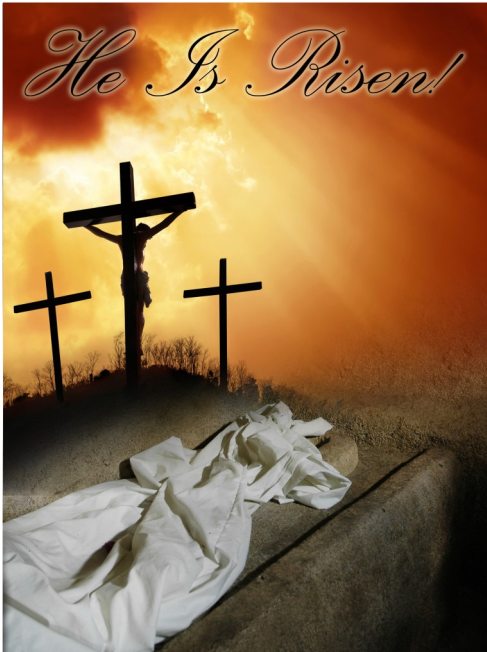

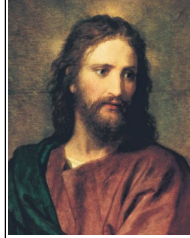

We will figure out an online sign-up (We can help you by email or phone if needed). Watch the bulletin and website for details!

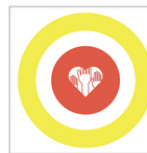
