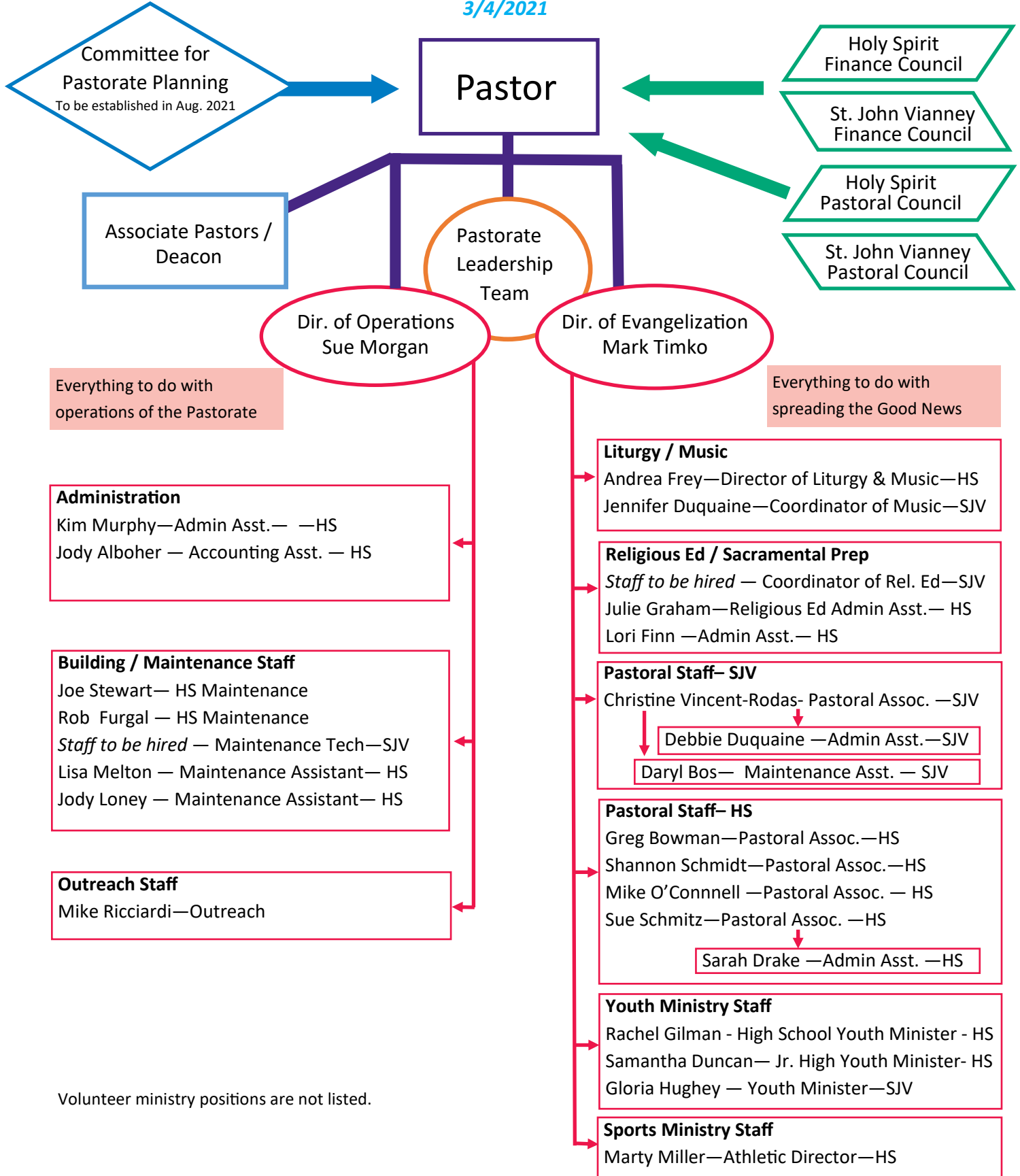

Director of Operations

Summary: The Director of Operations will serve as professional administrator and strategic leader for both Parishes in a Pastorate. The Director of Operations will work closely with the Pastor to drive positive financial performance of the Parishes and steward of resources.

The Director of Operations assists the Pastor with the stewardship of the human, financial, and physical resources of the Parish, in accordance with diocesan policies and guidelines. This role will have responsibility for leadership of operations staff (bookkeepers, office, and maintenance staff).

Director of Evangelization, Family Life, and Pastoral Ministries

Summary: The Director of Evangelization, Family Life, and Pastoral Ministries will assist the Missionary Pastor with the pastoral care of the Pastorate. This role includes pastoral planning along with supervision of Directors and/or Coordinators of the following ministry areas: Lifelong Formation, Liturgy and Music, Pastoral Care and Community Care, Sports Ministry, and other Parish Ministries . The Director of Evangelization, Family Life, and Pastoral Ministries supports, accompanies, and equips the leaders in these ministerial areas to focus their attention beyond parishioners and into the community at large as they strive to facilitate making disciples of Jesus Christ, building vibrant communities of faith and inspiring men and women to be witnesses of Christ to the world.

In the context of Uniting in Heart 2030, the Director of Evangelization, Family Life, and Pastoral Ministries serves on the leadership team and ensures the participation and faithful witness of the laity in the Church's pastoral mission and in all ministries of the parish.

Pastorate Leadership Team

Summary: The Pastorate Leadership Team is a team of 3–5 key staff people who assist the Pastor in making important day-to-day decisions and provide a structure of accountability. They help move forward the vision of pastoral renewal. The Director of Operations and Director of Evangelization, Family Life, and Pastoral Ministries are members of this team. The team is appointed by the pastor and assist in implementation of the pastoral plan.

Committee for Pastoral Planning

Summary: The Committee for Pastoral Planning works to gather data and develop the pastoral plan for the Pastorate. It consists of staff and parishioners from both Holy Spirit and St. John Vianney Parishes. There will be representative from finance and parish councils of both parishes. They will participate in the training for pastoral planning and gather data, evaluate data, and draft a three-year plan.
