Culture of LIFE October 2020



Thank you to all that stood with us Sunday, October 4, 2020 at the very wet Life Chain on Atlantic Boulevard. Standing with me, Bernie and Butch were Father Boddie, Father Cowart, our nuns, and about 25 other CTK parishioners. We had many other churches also, stretching from Monument to St Johns Bluff, 2:00 to 3:30 p.m. Only in Jacksonville? No, in 2020 there are life chains scheduled Oct. 4 and Nov. 1 at over 2,000 cities in the United States.
