I want to thank everyone for their prayers during the time of my kidney transplant. The transplant was performed on December 29, 2020 at the Mayo Clinic. Some internal bleeding required a second surgery on January 2, 2021. I arrived home on January 6th. I am feeling a little better and stronger every day. I cannot have any personal contact for about two months, other than at a distance and wearing a mask.

The kidney starting working immediately (sometime it takes several days) and seems to be performing well based on the labs.
