There is no cost to participants.

If you have not yet made your **Lenten Resolution**, **God** invites you and your family to come and encounter **the power of the Holy Spirit** on March 13-15. If you have already made the Sacrament of Reconciliation one of your Lenten resolutions, note that as part of the second day, on **Tuesday**, **March 14**, we will have our Lenten Penance Service with 15 priests to assist us.

May our upcoming Fire It Up Family Mission bring to each of us the **power and joy of the Holy Spirit**! May we all enter into a **new relationship with Our Lord Jesus Christ**! May our parish become a **stronger family of families**!
