



High School Application Process for Parents and Guardians of 7th Grade Graders 2021-2022

1. On Wednesday, November 10, 2021, the Admissions Application will be posted online (<https://nolacatholicschools.orgsecondary-admissions>) and on individual high school websites. Only one application is permitted per student.
2. On the last line of this application form, identify the *selected high school* your child hopes to attend for the 2022-2023 school year. Students may select only ONE high school.
3. In addition to the Archdiocesan application form, each high school has an individual application on their website. Please complete the school application and submit it as well.
4. Parental/Guardian signature(s) on the back of the application form authorizes and permits other Catholic high schools (that may have openings) to review the student records in the event that the *selected high school* does not accept the student application.
5. If your child is in a Catholic school, return the application to the elementary school principal by Friday, November 12, 2021.
6. If your child is not in a Catholic elementary/middle school, the application should be submitted to the *selected high school*, along with transcripts/report cards, copy of birth certificate, copy of social security, standardized test scores, immunization records, copy of baptismal certificate, and any other pertinent records.
7. Students are required to attend Commitment/Testing Day at the *selected high school* on January 8, 2022. A \$30 one time, non-refundable, non-transferable application fee will be collected from each student upon arrival and check-in at the *selected high school*. (Note: Some of the high schools include this fee with the initial application fee. Please check with the selected high school). Exact starting times are determined by each individual school. Although all records are taken into consideration, results of testing administered on this day may be used not only to determine high school placement, but also to determine admission.
8. In the event that a student is not accepted at the *selected high school*, the parent/guardian will be notified by the school as soon as the determination is made. At that point, the parent/guardian may pick up the original application from the school and bring it to another school to apply there. If the folder is not picked up, it will be forwarded to the Department of Catholic Education and Faith Formation.
9. All folders of non-accepted students will be forwarded by the high schools to the Department of Catholic Education and Faith Formation. Unless otherwise indicated, all high schools will have the opportunity to review the folders and possibly offer an invitation to apply.



10. Non-accepted students may receive invitations to apply from schools that have reviewed those folders. It is not a guarantee of acceptance, but notes that the student may be a good fit at that school.
11. Acceptance notifications will take place Friday, February 18, 2022.
