Principles for Giving - Modern Interpretation of the Biblical Tithe

As a symbol of my total commitment to Christ, I give back to God:

In thanksgiving and gratitude for all that God has given to me

As a sacrifice – both meanings of the word

- to make something holy
- to do without something – to reorder my priorities

In a planned way – my gift comes from my first fruits – off the top

In proportion to what I have received – a tithe of my time, talent, treasure and assets

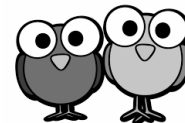
- 4% to my parish
- 1% to my diocese
- 5% to other worthy charities, i.e., Universal Church ministries, United Way, college, community and/or international charities.

If your personal situation does not allow you to give a full 10% of your time, talent, and treasure then prayerfully discern the stewardship level you can offer at this time.

The Bulletin on October 19th/ 20th will have a listing of all the ministries. There will be people representing all the ministries at various tables in the Parish Hall on the 27th, so you can ask any questions you may have and sign up. On Saturday, the 26th, there will be several people available from the "Saturday Crew" to also answer questions and help you sign up.
