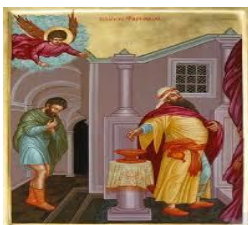

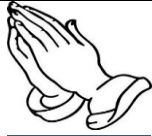

During the month of November, the St. Francis of Assisi St. Vincent de Paul Conference will be collecting personal hygiene items for NNEMAP Food Pantry. Our support goes to NNEMAP because the food pantry serves the neighbors in the 43215 zip code and this is the zip code assigned to our conference. Plastic bags with labels listing the products needed will be handed out at Commitment Sunday and after mass the following Sunday. Labels list the items: Toothbrush, toothpaste, dental floss, shaving cream, deodorant, bar soap, lotion, razor, wash cloth. Please take a bag (or more if you wish) and fill it with these items. The donation box will be at the entrance of the church for you to drop these off. Personal hygiene items are valued by the neighbors who shop the food pantry. NNEMAP food pantry funds are used to purchase healthy food items for the neighbors. These items can't be purchased through the SNAP program. Any donation you make will be appreciated by those who many times don't have the money for these items.
