LECTIO DIVINA

We were wondering about how to better assist you spiritually in your day-to-day life and we have found the Lectio Divina in an email format for you.

In Christianity, *Lectio Divina* (Latin for "Divine Reading") is a traditional monastic practice of scriptural reading, meditation and prayer intended to promote communion with God and to increase the knowledge of God's word. It does not treat scripture as texts to be studied, but as the living word.

Traditionally, *Lectio Divina* has four separate steps: read; meditate; pray; contemplate. First a passage of scripture is read, then its meaning is reflected upon. This is followed by prayer and contemplation on the Word of God.

Every week, some parishes make available the Lectio Divina for the scripture readings from Monday thru Saturday. We are pleased that we can bring this to you. We wish we could print it out for everyone, but the cost is a bit out of range right now.
