Collin Geddis is the recruitment coordinator for the Ohio Reading and Math Corps, which is an AmeriCorps program that places members into elementary schools to tutor kids that need a little extra intervention to succeed. He is reaching out to you because starting next school year there will be the need for dedicated community members in multiple Columbus area elementary schools including Education Solutions Elementary.

Ohio Reading Corps is a great opportunity for volunteers to get involved in the community on a regular basis and make a meaningful impact on the lives of children, not only academically but on a personal level

The members are in the same schools daily during normal school hours working with the same children on literacy. In exchange for service members receive a stipend of \$800 a month and upon completion of the program a \$2,950 education award, which can be used for tuition or student loans. The education award can also be passed down to children or grandchildren.

Currently we have members from ages 18-80 in our program, so all ages are welcome! And there is no need for a teaching license because all member receive exceptional training before entering their schools.
