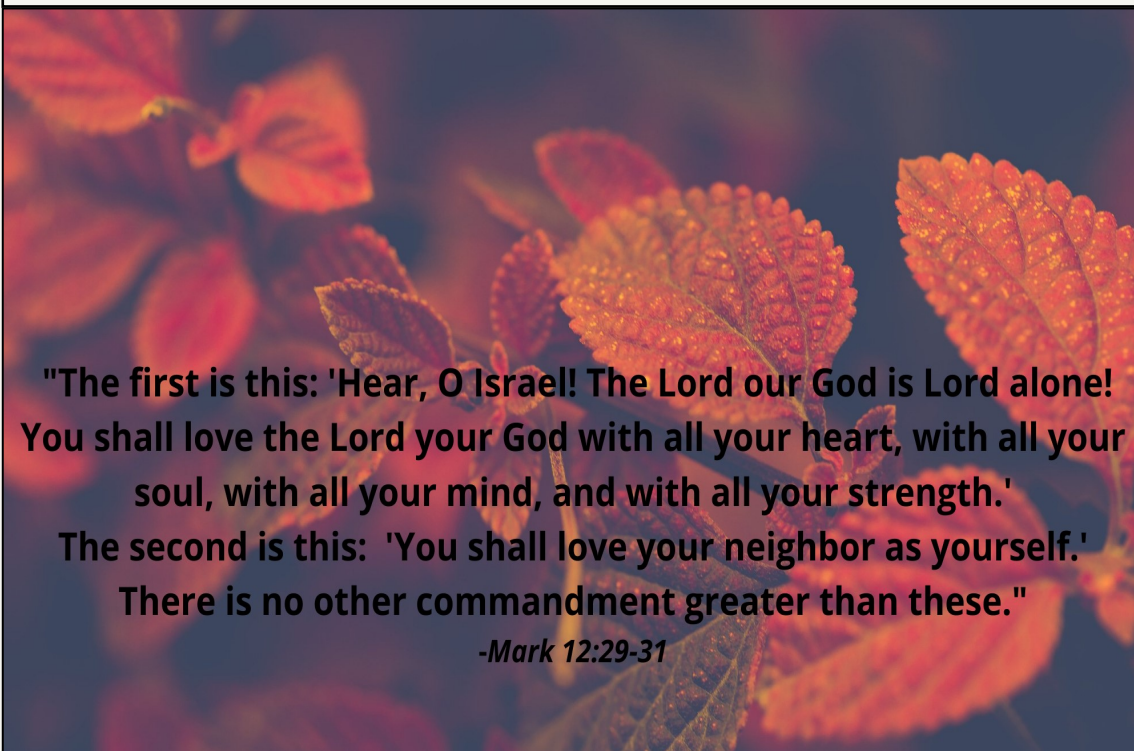

Today we welcome Jefferson McConnaughey on the Barckhoff organ bench as Laurel is taking a well-earned Sunday off. Next weekend (11/7) Laurel will celebrate her 35th Anniversary working as a Church Organist. Laurel began piano lessons at the age of 7 and then organ lessons in her teens. In November of 1986, she was hired at the United Church of Christ in Suffield, Ohio. Since then, she has worked at several churches in both Northeast Ohio, where she grew up, and here in Central Ohio. We are greatly blessed that she joined the staff at St. Francis of Assisi in January of 2010. Her masterful playing of the Barckhoff—an older style ‘tracking’ organ, with a flat pedal board—enhances our worship and allows us to fully participate in the liturgy. Next Sunday, please plan to arrive a bit early (and stay late) to listen to the special pieces she has prepared for prelude (Praeludium in D minor by Pachelbel) and postlude (Tocatta from the 5th Organ Symphony by Widor) in honor of her 35th Anniversary. The prelude will begin approximately 7 minutes prior to the start of Mass.
