

## Commonly Asked Questions

### **1. Does my child need to attend every session?**

As with any study, the more you put into it, the more you will receive. It would be wonderful to have your child participate every week. However, we understand that every week will not be feasible. It would be beneficial for your son or daughter to attend as many sessions as possible.

### **2. What if my child attends a Catholic School?**

Our hope is to enhance the religious education your son/daughter is already learning through his/her school. In youth ministry, we have a unique opportunity to teach these nights outside the classroom setting. We will be creating an environment that surrounds them with peers that are eager to learn and apply these lessons to their everyday lives.

### **3. What if I cannot afford the cost?**

### **5. If I register for Antioch, am I automatically registered for Confirmation?**

1. **NO.** Although we encourage our confirmation students to attend our youth ministry events throughout the year, it is not a requirement to enroll in Antioch in order to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.
2. We have nearly 400 students eligible for confirmation. You must attend a Parent meeting in the Fall to Pre-register your child **and** attend a Parent meeting in the Spring to finalize your registration.
