ELA- Next week, we will be moving into Unit 2 in My View, the theme is I Spy, and we will read stories of informational text as well as poetry and drama. We will be focusing on long vowel sounds. We continue to do writing assignments in our journals as well as in writer's workshop with a focus on handwriting, grammar and spelling.

Math- Next week, we will be finishing our unit on addition and subtraction to 10. Then we will move into Module 2, which is place value to 20 with addition and subtraction. We are using Zearn in the classroom as well.

Religion- We are starting Unit 2, which is Followers of Jesus. We will also talk about all of the special things that we are thankful for in our lives.

Science- Our next unit will be patterns of Seasons and Weather. We will discuss things such as daylight and the seasons and types of weather relating to the seasons.

Social Studies- The students have really been enjoying our Studies Weekly issues. They have many interesting articles about topics that are relatable to the children. We will spend some time discussing and doing a compare/contrast of the First Thanksgiving with our Thanksgiving of today.
