During the month of January we will be focusing on the following topics:

Religion: We will be learning about the Sacrament of Confirmation and how we can turn to the Holy Spirit for comfort and guidance, for strength and peace.

ELA: We will continue to explore point of view with the novel, *The Road to Freedom*. We will analyze different parts of a story's structure and how illustrations help readers understand important story elements. We will also be learning about subjects and predicates.

Math: We will complete our work on Module 2: Multiplication of Multi-digit Whole Numbers using mental strategies and the standard algorithm to solve. We will begin using whole number multiplication to express equivalent measurements.

Science: We will be studying Earth's water cycle, the role of water in Earth's processes, and provide evidence about the distribution of water on Earth.

Social Studies: In Social Studies, we will complete our study of Canada's provinces of Quebec, Saskatchewan, and British Columbia. We will also begin studying maps and globes, defining the 5 themes of geography and how we use them in our daily lives.
