

# First Grade News-March 2021

A new month brings some new units of study for the First Grade! We continue to work on math facts, as well as strengthening our reading and writing skills daily in the classroom.

In Math, we will continue our unit on measurement and graphing. We will then move onto place value of tens and ones. We will start this unit by using pictures to learn and understand place value and then learn strategies for addition and subtraction of 2 digit numbers.

In ELA, we are beginning our new unit in My View which is Making History. We will read and discuss stories about famous American people, symbols, and technology. We will learn about types of literature such as biographies and Historical Fiction. We will continue to work on writing more complex sentences as well as longer paragraphs.
