During the month of March, we will be focusing on the following topics:

Religion: We will be learning about the Sacrament of Reconciliation and how we are called to turn to God with all our heart. We will also be studying the history and meaning of Lent.

ELA: We will continue to focus on main ideas and cause and effect relationships. We will also compare the point of view of different writers and their points of view. Our texts will include, *The Great Migration and Angel Island*. We will also be learning about adverbs.

Math: We will begin working on Module 3: Adding and Subtracting Fractions. We will begin with review of fourth grade understandings and move into more complex problems involving addition and subtraction of fractions.

Science: We will begin investigating human impacts on Earth's systems while investigating ways to reduce our impact on the environment.

Social Studies: In Social Studies, we will continue studying Latin America. We will be studying early civilizations found in Latin America and their greatest accomplishments.
