Updates from Father

Relationships can be hard to mend...and in the gospel, Jesus offers us a way to heal those broken relationships in our lives.

So, what are Jesus' instructions about how to heal a broken relationship? Well, He says the first step is to speak directly to the individual (and privately) who did the harm. One of the worse things is to hold grudges; it can damage the heart and make it harder to face the person.

If we need to face a person to settle things, we need to do it face to face. If that does not work, then the next step is to bring another person (or persons) as a third party (usually it's a person who is even keel). The goal is reconciliation, not to put the other person on trial!

If bringing another person does not help, then we need to seek the help of the Christian community because other members can pray and seek a solution based on Christian love rather than force or legal action!

If the Christian community cannot help, we need to remember the Gospels that Jesus often broke bread with those who were seen as "offenders" (tax-collectors) and refused no one who is open to receive pardon and healing!

When we are offended, are we willing to set aside any ill will in order to help others heal? Jesus wants to set us free from resentment and an unwillingness to forgive and the love of Christ sets us free to do those things!

We also must never give up on praying for them as well, and with God's help, we must try to heal them with God's love and wisdom!

May we always try to mend broken relationships and be Jesus' instrument of love and peace!

- Pray for Pope Francis and those who lead the Church, especially Bishop Brennan
- Pray for those affected by natural disasters and acts of violence (COVID-19 Pandemic; violence due to racism; typhoons in Korea; damage from Hurricane Laura; Hurricane Nana; wildfires in CA)
- Pray for the safety of schools (especially St. Mary school)
