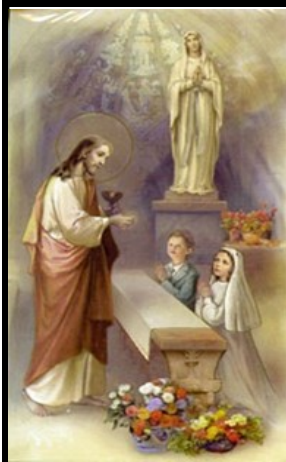

Exaltation of the Holy Cross, also called Universal **Exaltation of the Holy** and Life-Giving **Cross** or **Holy**

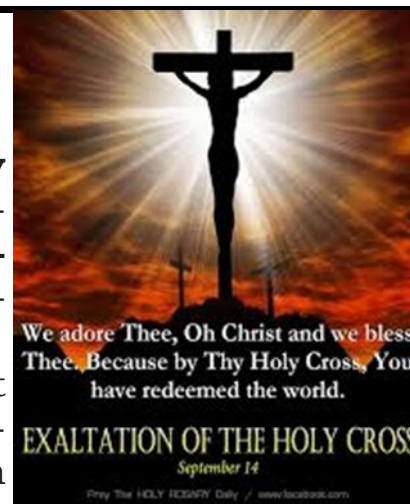
Cross Day, liturgical feast celebrated on September 14 to honour the **cross** on which Jesus Christ was

crucified. ... The universal symbol of the Christian faith, the **cross** represents Christ's victory over death.

The cross of triumph is usually pictured as a globe with the cross on top, symbolic of the triumph of our Savior over the sin of the world, and world conquest of His Gospel through the means of a grace.
