- FULL RENOVATION OF BOTH RESTROOMS AT THE PARISH HALL WAS COMPLETED IN MAY. WORK INCLUDED: RENOVATION OF THE FLOOR \$3960 AND PLUMBING WITH NEW PARTS: \$6750
- ROOF LEAKS AND CUPS ON THE CHIMNEYS AND INSPECTION OF THE ROOF AND CHIMNEYS: TOTAL COST: \$9300 (WORK WAS DONE: PARTLY IN OCTOBER 2017 AND FINISHED IN APRIL 2018 INCLUDING THE RENT OF THE LIFT)
