

COVID PRECAUTIONS

Current Covid Guidelines:

- Every pew will be used.
- Hymnals will be available (while singing in the congregation, it is asked that a mask be worn).
- Masks are encouraged but not mandatory.
- Only the Communion Host will be offered, received in your extended flat hand, to minimize contact. (Please refrain from receiving on the tongue at this time.)
- Ministries will be limited to a few specifically chosen people – no ministry schedule for now.
- Collection baskets will sit near the Church entrances/exits.

The general dispensation from attending the Sunday Mass will be lifted as of June 5/6, 2021. However, a particular dispensation still applies:

If you are in any of the following categories, please stay home and join in a Spiritual Communion via one of the virtual celebrations of the Mass being broadcast throughout the Diocese and beyond:

- Positive for COVID-19 or had contact with someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Running a fever.
- Have a cough or COVID/flu like symptoms.
- Are in the 'at risk' category due to—age 60 or older, compromised immune system, diabetes, serious heart condition.
- Believe attending Mass would pose an undue risk to other family members such as elderly parents you are caring for.
