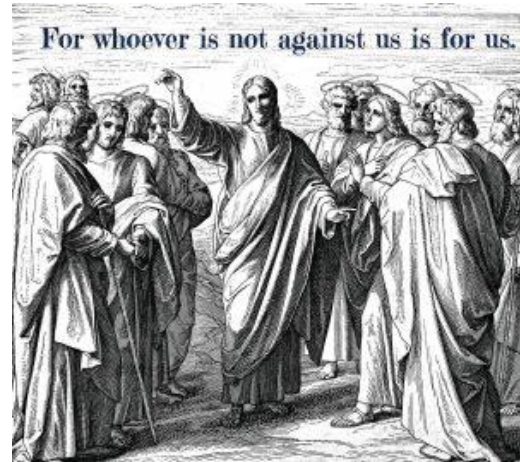

I am just getting ready to start my junior year of college seminary. First we will spend a weeklong retreat with Jesus to get the year started off right. Then classes begin. My classes are Spanish 3, two philosophy courses, geology, and Pastoral Ministry. My apostolate this semester is working with Catholic Men's Leadership. It is an outreach that tries to keep college men involved in their faith, because so many fall away from their faith when they leave home. My semester abroad in Rome was changed from this fall to the spring semester, so I plan to be there after Christmas break.

WHAT IS EUCHARISTIC ADORATION?

Eucharistic Adoration is adoring and honoring the Eucharistic presence of Christ. In a deeper sense, it involves the contemplation of the Mystery of Christ truly present before us.

During Eucharistic Adoration, we open ourselves to the presence of the Risen Lord, to receive his graces more fully. By worshipping the Eucharistic Jesus, we become what God wants us to be. Like a magnet, the Lord draws us to himself and gently transforms us.

In its fullest sense, the Eucharistic Adoration is "God and man reaching out for each other at the same time." Currently at our parish, we offer Adoration the first Friday of the month from 9:30am-8pm.
