- ✓ Distribution of the Holy Communion via the chalice

In addition to these precautionary health measures, Fr. Michael has **temporarily suspended coffee & donuts after Mass**. Fr. Michael also recommends that we use the **hand sanitizer** offered at the entrance of the church, in the stewardship hall, and in the log church.
