- ✚ In the light of the deepening COVID 19 crisis, all Churches of the Archdiocese are closed until further notice.
- ✚ Churches will no longer be open for private prayer until further notice, but confession is available by appointment.
- ✚ The suspension of public Masses and all other gatherings is extended until further notice.
- ✚ All remain dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. Still, remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.
- ✚ Priests will continue to offer daily private Mass and when possible, live-stream Mass.
- ✚ The public celebrations of Holy Week liturgies are suspended. These liturgies will be live-streamed from the cathedral and from the parishes that have live-streaming capability.
- ✚ The Christian Initiation of the Elect and/or the Reception into Full Communion and Confirmation of baptized candidates at the Easter Vigil are postponed until after public Masses resume. Pastors will determine date and time.
- ✚ First Holy Communion is postponed until after public Masses resume. Pastors will determine the date and time.
- ✚ Confirmations will be rescheduled for the fall.
