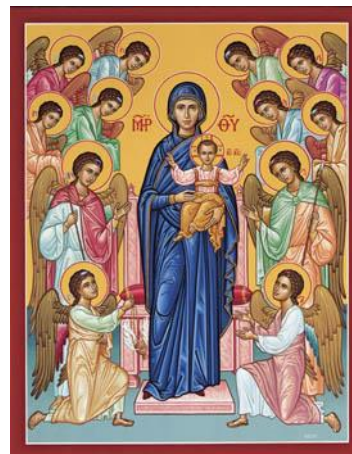

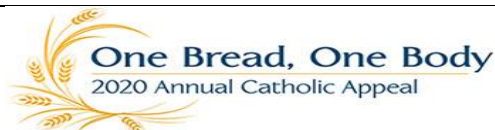

## Faith Formation Online Registration Update

---

This fall our parish will be moving toward an online program to partner with our Sunday and Wednesday night classes. The program, called My Catholic Faith Delivered, is an online version of the Faith and Life series published by Ignatius Press. When our class schedule begins September 13, it is our hope that students and parents will view the assigned lesson during the week, and that the class time that follows on either Sunday (K-6) or Wednesday (7-Confirmation) will serve as a follow-up to the lesson with discussion, activities, or presentations to reinforce the main ideas and promote a better understanding of the lesson material.

In order for this to happen, we need all families who are planning to participate in the Faith Formation Program (FFP) to register by August 10 so that we can proceed with the enrollment process—both online and within our parish. Online registration is easy. Simply go to [kenaicatholicchurch.org](http://kenaicatholicchurch.org) and click on the first entry—My Catholic Faith Delivered. The registration form will pop up. Please submit a registration form for each child.

For families who do not have internet or personal electronic devices, hard copies of the registration form are available in the foyer. Hard-copy samples of the Faith and Life books are also available at the church for you to look at. You may then wish to order your own home copy of the various grade levels that you will need.

Should a time arise when the church is again closed due to the pandemic or for any other reason, we now have a way to maintain our FFP. This is a trial year and we will learn as we go. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask Rosemary Bird, DRE, or Fr. Michael.

## One Minute Study

---

### **Question:**

Why does the Liturgy follow a planned format each Sunday and why do we need to do things in this order?

### **Answer:**

The Church, being an Apostolic Church, finds its unity in the relationship between Christ, the Bishop (Apostle) and parish Priest and the flock (all the lay people) entrusted to the care of the Bishop and Priest. This unity began with Christ giving his life for the Church on the Cross and calling the first twelve Apostles (Bishops) to 'go forth into all the world and preach the good news' (Matthew 16-15). Christ called and ordained and sent forth. This was the Order He established so that every person on this earth would hear the good news. As Catholics we have received this ordering of things from Christ to share the good news which is reflected in the order of the liturgy. The liturgy of the Mass, which we participate in daily, is meant to reflect what Christ wanted everyone to know about. It is in a nutshell the whole story of Christ's mission and the mission of the Apostles. Let us continue this next week, so stay tuned for more on this question.
