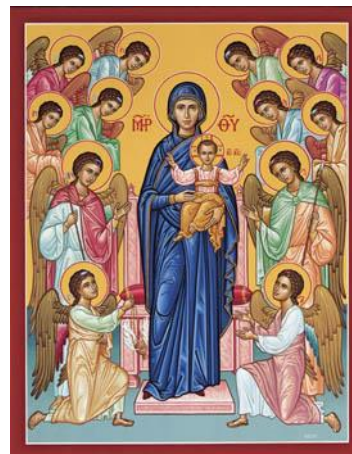

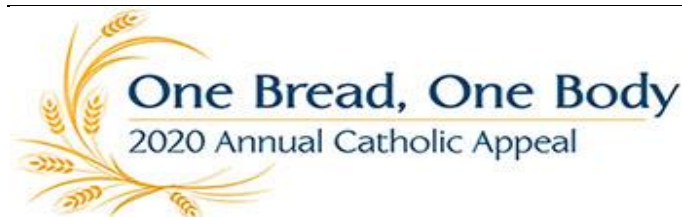

## Faith Formation Online Registration Update

---

This fall our parish will be moving toward an online program to partner with our Sunday and Wednesday night classes. The program, called My Catholic Faith Delivered, is an online version of the Faith and Life series published by Ignatius Press. When our class schedule begins September 13, it is our hope that students and parents will view the assigned lesson during the week, and that the class time that follows on either Sunday (K-6) or Wednesday (7-Confirmation) will serve as a follow-up to the lesson with discussion, activities, or presentations to reinforce the main ideas and promote a better understanding of the lesson material.

In order for this to happen, we need all families who are planning to participate in the Faith Formation Program (FFP) to register by August 10 so that we can proceed with the enrollment process—both online and within our parish. Online registration is easy. Simply go to [kenaicatholicchurch.org](http://kenaicatholicchurch.org) and click on the first entry—My Catholic Faith Delivered. The registration form will pop up. Please submit a registration form for each child.

For families who do not have internet or personal electronic devices, hard copies of the registration form are available in the foyer. Hard-copy samples of the Faith and Life books are also available at the church for you to look at. You may then wish to order your own home copy of the various grade levels that you will need.

Should a time arise when the church is again closed due to the pandemic or for any other reason, we now have a way to maintain our FFP. This is a trial year and we will learn as we go. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask Rosemary Bird, DRE, or Fr. Michael.

## **One Minute Study**

Let us continue answering the question about order and Unity in the Church and in the Mass. Last week we spoke of how the Mass is a complete education in what Christ wanted to teach us about himself and his Mission and thus ours, being part of the body of Christ. In order to see the fuller picture, let us begin in the beginning with Genesis and see how this ordering began.

In the beginning we see a void, a complete emptiness, nothing created. Then God hovered over the void and creation began. "God said, Let there be light and there was light...". Take a meditative moment and read Genesis Chapter 1 to read about the order of creation established in the expression of the Word of God. In Chapter 2 verse 1-3 we see God's summary of his 'work', "And on the seventh day God finished his work which he had done. ..., and he rested on the seventh... So God blessed the seventh day and hallowed it, because on it God rested from all his work which he had done in creation". St Augustine in his work the, City of God, posits that the first Light of creation was the angelic realm. A separation between light and darkness was made. Does this point to the choice of the angels to obey the order of God or to separate from His Divine Will? (REV 12 7-10) Truly from the very moment of creation God shows us He has an order that all creation is intended to participate in or to fall outside of His Divine Plan. The theme of order, the Divine Will is clearly present from literally, Day one. Again let us take up more of this theme next week.
