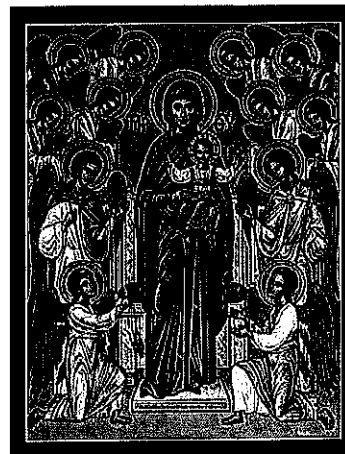

Faith Formation Online Registration Update

This fall our parish will be moving toward an online program to partner with our Sunday and Wednesday night classes. The program, called My Catholic Faith Delivered, is an online version of the Faith and Life series published by Ignatius Press. When our class schedule begins September 13, it is our hope that students and parents will view the assigned lesson during the week, and that the class time that follows on either Sunday (K-6) or Wednesday (7-Confirmation) will serve as a follow-up to the lesson with discussion, activities, or presentations to reinforce the main ideas and promote a better understanding of the lesson material.

In order for this to happen, we need all families who are planning to participate in the Faith Formation Program (FFP) to register by August 10 so that we can proceed with the enrollment process—both online and within our parish. Online registration is easy. Simply go to kenaicatholicchurch.org and click on the first entry—My Catholic Faith Delivered. The registration form will pop up. Please submit a registration form for each child.

For families who do not have internet or personal electronic devices, hard copies of the registration form are available in the foyer. Hard-copy samples of the Faith and Life books are also available at the church for you to look at. You may then wish to order your own home copy of the various grade levels that you will need.

Should a time arise when the church is again closed due to the pandemic or for any other reason, we now have a way to maintain our FFP. This is a trial year and we will learn as we go. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask Rosemary Bird, DRE, or Fr. Michael.

One Minute Study

From last week, we saw that from the very beginning God created an order for all creation. When he created man and woman, he gave them a job to order the garden of Eden inside the purpose which God had given. One rule he asked of Adam and Eve, not to eat of the fruit of the tree of Good and Evil. When they broke that rule, the relationship with God was damaged and they no longer walked in peace with God but hid themselves. Once the order God created was broken, disharmony came into the world. Yet God showed his great mercy and promised a redeemer to fix the disharmony between Man and God. Throughout the Old Testament we can see how God called and formed his chosen people who would proclaim to the world knowledge of the One True God. Yet the chosen people forgot time after time their mission to be God's people, broke the covenants over and over again. Finally God sent his only Son to the world who would teach everyone who the One True God is and, indeed, Jesus said of himself, "He who has seen me has seen the Father." Christ wanted us to know how much the Holy Trinity sought to have a relationship with each of us. The Trinity wanted to be so present to us, that through Christ, our God gave himself to us through the Church, the sacraments, most intimately through the sacrament of the Eucharist. Christ pitches his tent (the tabernacle) in our midst and waits for us to come and sojourn with Him as did the Hebrews when they pitched a tent in the desert to house the ark of the Covenant so they could be near him and he could be near them. Once again, let us take this up once again next week.
