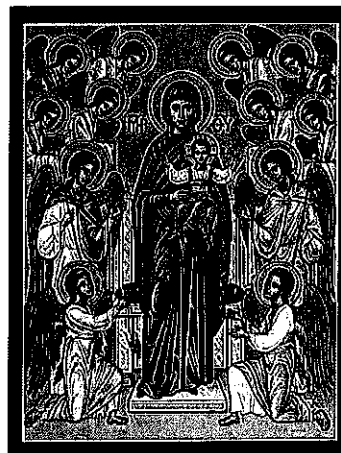

### K-4

Be sure to listen to the **Catholic Sprouts** podcast this week as there are some power hitters of the Catholic faith being celebrated this week. August 27<sup>th</sup> is the feast day of St. Monica. Consider watching *My Catholic Family – St. Monica* on YouTube and the *Story of Saint Augustine* by Christian Kids TV, also on YouTube.

### 5-6

Consider watching *Catholic Heroes of the Faith: The Story of Saint Augustine* on FORMED for the Feast Days of St. Monica whose feast day is the 27<sup>th</sup> & her son, St. Augustine whose feast day is the 28<sup>th</sup>. With August 29<sup>th</sup> celebrating the Passion of St. John the Baptist, FORMED recommends watching *The Saints: Our Heavenly Friends*.

### 7-11 & Confirmation Students

Let's continue with FORMED series, *The Wild Goose* with Fr. Dave Pivonka: This week is episode #2: Breath of God. "The only way we are able to live a life of faith, a life full of love, peace, joy, and power is by the Holy Spirit. This experience of the Holy Spirit is an encounter available to everyone; it is not reserved for a select few. Pentecost and the transforming power of the Holy Spirit is the theme of this segment."

### Adults, Gr. 11-12

In celebration of St. Augustine, look at *Augustine: A Voice for all Generations*. Explore the conversion story of one of the most significant figures in Church history and learn about his struggle to find answers amid a sea of competing voices. If you are looking for a way to draw closer to Jesus through Mary, the FORMED study and online retreat, *33 Days to Morning Glory*, is a wonderful way to do this.

# One Minute Study

To continue from last week, God wants to be close to his people. He wants to draw us close to Him. In the Mass, we see this action daily. We begin with gathering around the place of worship, the Altar. We express our need for Christ by acknowledging our sinfulness. Then we sit to hear the word of God from the Old Testament, the Psalms and then the New Testament. God reveals himself to us. Through the Homily, the Priest tries to make the readings present to our moment in history. Then we enter into the sacrifice which Christ at the Last Supper commanded "Do this in Memory of me" John 22:19. We receive Christ into our bodies and He receives us in an intimate union that will only be understood fully when we are in Heaven. Finally, we are sent forth to give this relationship with Christ to the world.

Our original question asked why we follow the order of the Mass each day and it is here I would like to point out that we follow the order of what Salvation History has given to us. God called his people. God forms us. He reveals himself to us and He gave us an everlasting Covenant that he wants us to renew with Him. It is his order.

So many reminders are in the church building to help our sense of what Christ wants us to remember. The Tabernacle is the focus of Christ dwelling with us. The Altar is the place of sacrifice which calls us to participate in the covenant. We have a crucifix close to the Altar that reminds us of what Christ gave of himself so that we could have a relationship with Him and the Trinity once again. Images of the Community of the Saints are present at times, i.e. statues, pictures. These images remind us that we have a 'cloud of witnesses' that stand by our side to help us in this community of charity to which we are called to belong. In some church buildings we see an image of the Resurrected Christ as we leave the church, to remind us of the hope that is ours because of what was sacrificed on the Altar. The immense love that our God wants to share with us is truly compressed in the liturgy and the environment which we create in which to celebrate the Eucharist. Let us continue with more questions next week.
