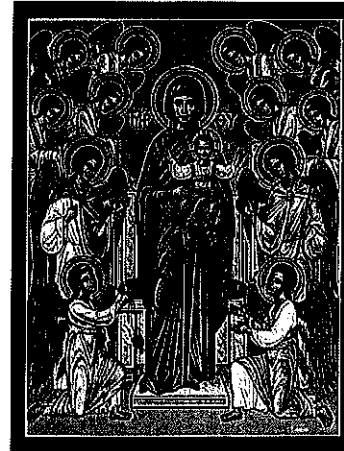

# One Minute Study

We left last week with the idea that we must preach both the cross and the resurrection. When Christ tells us that in order to be his followers we must take up our cross daily, is he not telling us that without the transformation that the cross can offer in our lives, we cannot know the resurrection? If we reject the one are we not rejecting the other? So how do we live with our daily cross to make it transformative and not a meaningless experience? Pope St. John Paul II gives us insight into this question not only by his life experiences (a great winter commitment could be to read the book, Witness to Hope, a deeply moving biography of Pope St. John Paul II) but also in his writings. In Evangelium vitae (no. 67), he tells us that, Living to the Lord ... means recognizing that suffering, while still an evil and a trial in itself, can always become a source of good. It becomes such if it is experienced for love and with love through sharing, by God's gracious gift and one's own personal and free choice, in the suffering of Christ Crucified. In this way, the person who lives his suffering in the Lord grows more fully conformed to him (cf. Phil 3:10; 1 Pet 2:21).

Being conformed to the Lord, becoming fully human, a creation made in the Image and Likeness of God, what could we desire more? As St. Augustine so famously states: Our hearts are restless until they rest in thee.

Next week let us take up this thought.
