

Frequently Asked Questions for Auction Night

Our goal for the evening of the auction is to safeguard as much as possible the health and safety of all in attendance, while complying with federal, local and state guidelines as they pertain to outdoor gatherings.

- **Can we purchase tickets at the door?**
Yes, however we strongly encourage you to purchase your ticket in advance. We cannot guarantee admission for those purchasing at the door once we reach capacity for the evening.
- **Will be masks be required?**
Yes, masks will be required when you are not seated at your table.
- **What if I forget my mask or misplace it throughout the evening?**
The committee will have masks on hand to provide for those who either forget to bring their masks or misplace it at the event.
- **How many people can sit at a table?**
We will limit seating to a maximum of 8 guest per table, unless from an immediate family or the same household. The tables will be arranged 6 feet apart and will be assigned when you purchase your ticket.
- **Can we bring our own food and beverages?**
Yes, this has always been part of the auction night tradition. The only change for this year is that we ask guests to only share with those at your table.
- **Will there be hand sanitizers and disinfecting wipes available?**
Yes, we will provide hand sanitizers and disinfecting wipes at every table and high traffic area.
- **Will temperatures be taken upon arrival?**
No, however we will send a COVID waiver form prior to the event where guests will answer prescreening questions and attest that they are not symptomatic and have not travelled to COVID hot spots. We ask that if you are not feeling well or have travelled to any of the states as prescribed by the Governor, that you not attend.
- **How will check in work?**
Guests will be pre-registered. When you purchase your ticket, you will be assigned a table, paddle number and be asked to sign the forms that would be typically signed the night of auction. This way, when you arrive, we will greet you at your car and give you your paddle and let you know where your table can be found.

If you purchase your ticket the night of the event, we will have a committee member escort you to your table and provide you with the forms to sign. They will then get your paddle for you and make sure to file the forms at the front desk on your behalf.
- **How will check out work?**
We will have a variety of tools the night of to ensure guests can check out safely from their phones. As always, we will also accept cash and check as a form of payment.
- **Will the silent auction portion be run the same way as in the past?**
There are several changes that have been made to the auction this year to safeguard the health of everyone in attendance. The

items will be set up towards the back of the middle lot, where there will be arrows that direct you how to navigate until the last item. If you wish to go back to an item, we ask that you walk all the way through to the exit of the silent tables and then make your way back around to the beginning of the silent line. We will have committee staff on hand to ensure guests are continuously moving and maintaining distance.

Once the silent auction is closed and winners are announced, committee staff will deliver your item directly to your table and will arrange payment.

- **Will the auction still be held in the event that the school is offering remote instruction?**
Yes, the auction will be held even if the school has switched to full remote instruction as it will be held outside.
- **Where will guests park?**
Guests are asked to park in the lower lot and to back into their parking spots.

- **Where will the event be held?**
The event will be held outside on the middle lot.
- **Where will guests be able to use the restroom?**
Guests will be able to use the restrooms found in the back of the church. There will be two single stall restrooms available for your use. There will be committee staff assigned to be attendants to ensure that the door knobs and sink handle get wiped down in between each use.
- **Will I be able to bid on items if I do not want to physically attend the auction?**
The committee is working on securing a platform that will allow guests to participate from home. Information will be shared closer to the date of the event.
- **Will there be a list of all attendees in the event that contact tracing is required?**
Yes, when a ticket is sold there will be information collected for these purposes.
