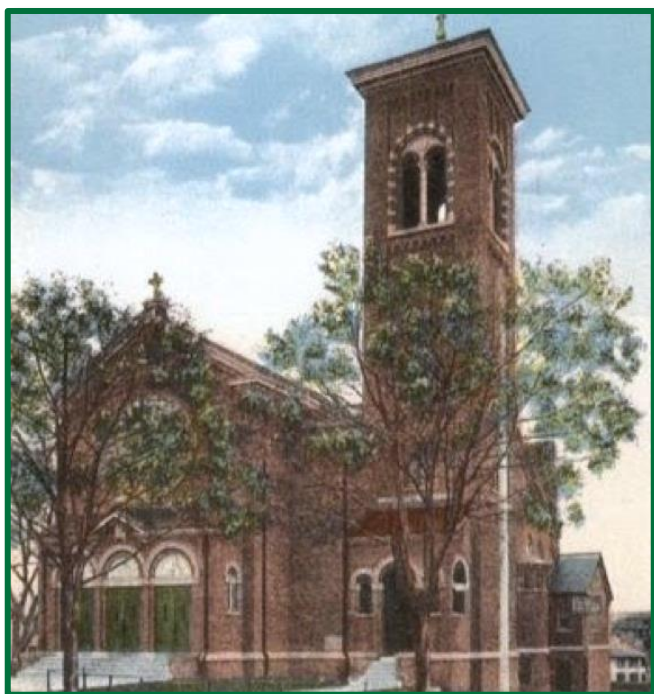

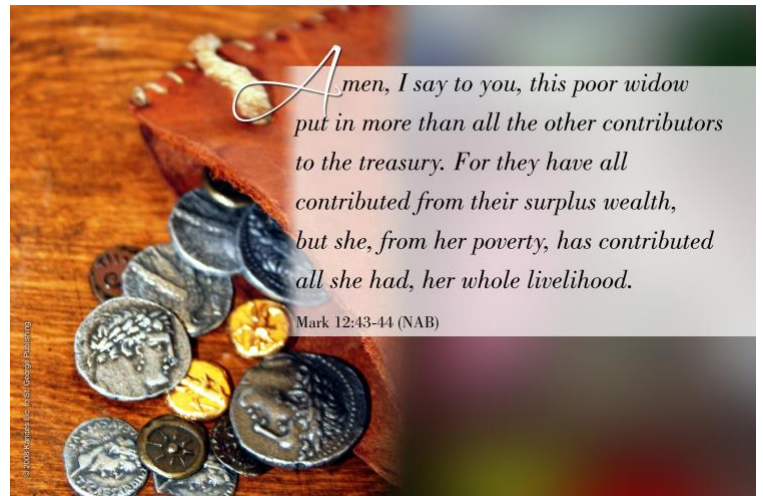

“FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES”

Have you ever thanked someone for an act of kindness, only to have them respond with, "It was nothing"? It is a funny response, because to you the act was obviously more than nothing! Why do we say that?? Perhaps it is because the act seemed trivial, and not worth mentioning. Compare this to the offerings of the widow in today's first reading. Elijah asked for bread and she said she had none to share. She had only a "handful of flour" and a little oil in her jug, and seemed ashamed that she could not offer him more. Maybe she is right -- her offering is a bit meager. But she gave what she had, and Elijah took what she offered. She gave ALL. In return for her selfless gift, God provided her with a bottomless jar of flour and a lifetime supply of oil. The lesson here is that no gift of self is too small. Give what you have and let God be the judge of its value -- I can assure you He will not see it as "nothing!" And the next time someone thanks you, don't brush off your act as something small and meaningless -- because to them it could have made all the difference.

Ella solo tenía un “puñado de harina” y tantito aceite en su una botella y se sentía avergonzada porque no podía ofrecerle más. Tal vez ella estaba en lo correcto y su ofrenda era un poco pobre, pero ella dio lo que tenía y Elías tomó lo que ella le ofreció. Ella lo dio TODO. A cambio de su desinteresado regalo, Dios le recompensó con una olla sin fondo llena de harina y una ración de por vida de aceite. La lección aquí es que ningún regalo desinteresado es pequeño. Den lo que tienen y dejen que Dios juzgue el valor; les aseguro que ÉL no lo verá como un “nada”. Y la próxima vez que alguien les agradezca, no hagan a un lado lo que han hecho como una cosa pequeña e insignificante, porque para ellos pudo haber hecho una gran diferencia en sus vidas.
