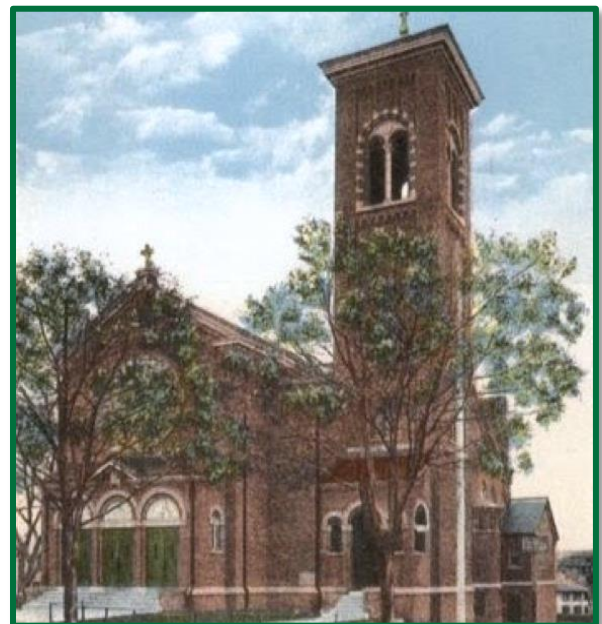

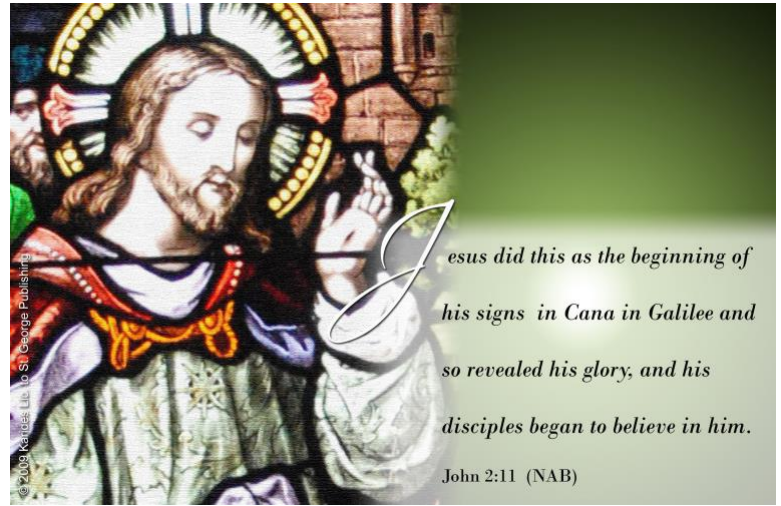
Prayer Before Mass

“FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES”

Christmas was nearly a month ago. Take a moment to reflect on the gifts you may have received...where are they now? Undoubtedly, some of those gifts have become prized possessions that get used daily. Some of them may have been put away for later use. Some of them may have been returned to the store, or even re-gifted. Let's be honest, people today don't always receive gifts with an open mind. We want what we want and we get rid of what we don't want. How does this behavior carry over to our acceptance of the gifts we have received from the Holy Spirit? Today's reading from 1 Corinthians tells us that we have each been given a unique gift that we did not choose. Rather, it was chosen specifically for us. What have we done with THAT gift? Is it prized and loved each day? Is it fully alive? Or did we hide it away for "later"? Paul tells us we should use that gift to allow the Holy Spirit to work through us -- but first, we have to accept the gift and get to know it. This comes through prayer and practice! Ask the Holy Spirit for guidance and allow Him to make you a little uncomfortable as He encourages you to use your gift in the lives of others!

“PLENAMENTE VIVOS COMO DISCÍPULOS MISIONEROS”

Seamos honestos, en estos tiempos, la gente no siempre recibe los regalos con una mente abierta; queremos lo que queremos y nos deshacemos de lo que no queremos. ¿Cómo este comportamiento se esparce a nuestra aceptación de los regalos que recibimos del Espíritu Santo? En la lectura de hoy de la 1era de Corintios, nos dice que cada uno de nosotros ha recibido un regalo único que no escogimos. Al contrario, ha sido escogido específicamente por nosotros. ¿Qué es lo que hemos hecho con ESE regalo? ¿Es valuado y amado cada día? ¿Está plenamente vivo? ¿O acaso está guardado para “después”? Pablo nos dice que debemos usar ese regalo para dejar que el Espíritu Santo trabaje por medio de nosotros, pero primero debemos de aceptar el regalo y aprender a conocerlo. Esto solo es posible por medio de la oración y la práctica. Pide al Espíritu Santo que te guíe y deja que!
