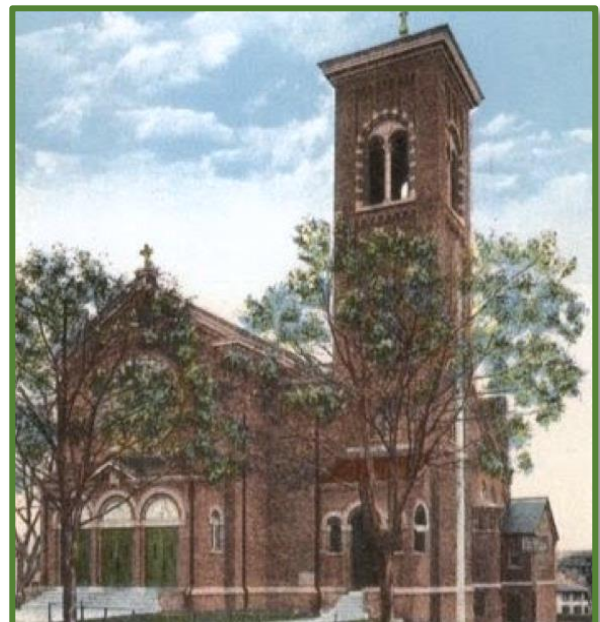

Prayer Before Mass

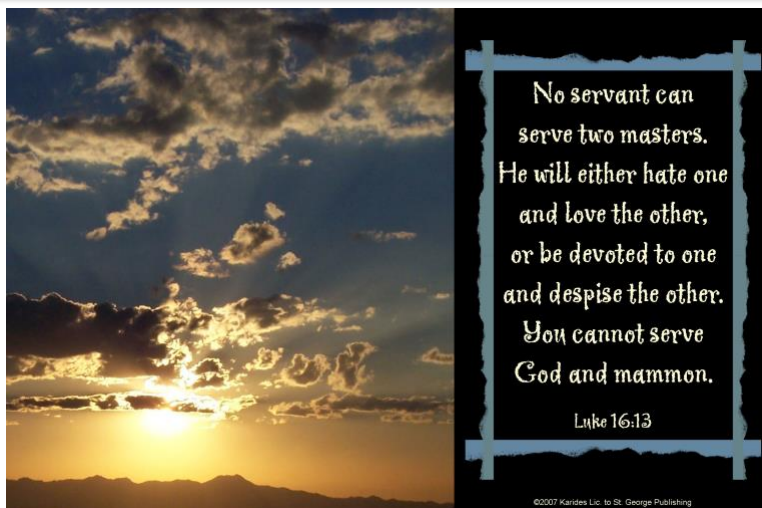
