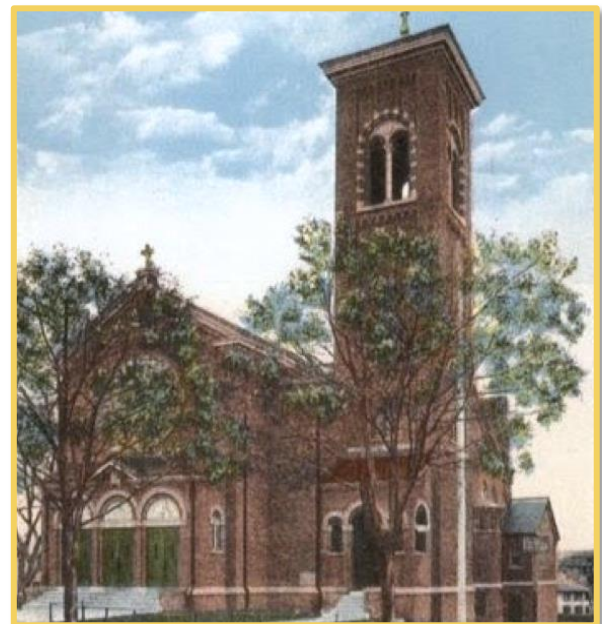

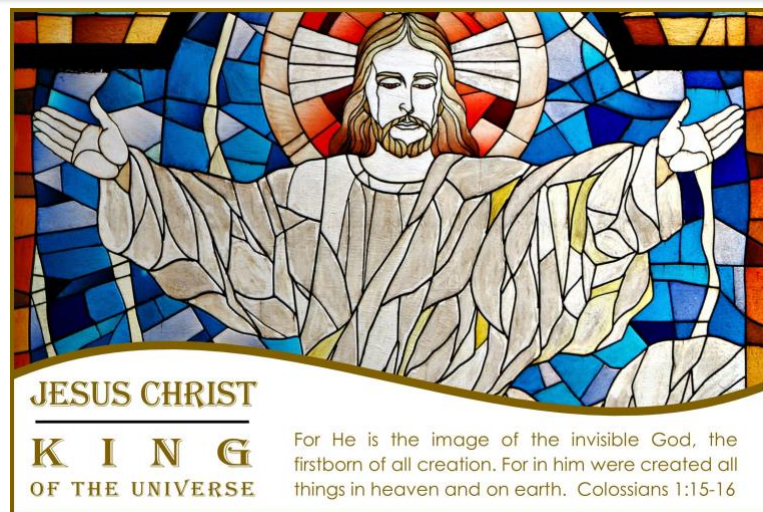
Oración Antes De La Misa
