Reflection

for this Sunday:

After Lent, the Easter season, and three Sundays of feast days - Pentecost, Most Holy Trinity, and Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ - the Church returns to Ordinary Time. This Sunday’s Gospel from Mark carries a significant message regarding faith and the Kingdom of God.

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time



In Mark’s Gospel, Jesus appears reluctant to His identity as the Son of God. After performing miracles of healing, He warns those cured to tell no and speaks to the crowds in parables, leaving them to discern His message. He explain the parable’s meaning only to His disciples and always in private at a later time.

Today’s Gospel reading consists of two parables about seeds: comparing sowing seeds and the tiny mustard seed to the kingdom of God. The emphasis is on the seed, which seems to have the power to grow on its own, much like the Kingdom of God. The mustard seed grows into a tree which provides a nesting place for birds, just as the kingdom of God welcomes and is open to us.

These parables help us discern something about the Kingdom of God and our own faith. In God we live and move and have our being, but God is a mystery and His Kingdom, though present, has not yet come into its fullness. Today, the Kingdom of God is present in the Church. The mission of proclaiming the Good News of the Kingdom, first given to the Apostles, is now given to us. But just as seeds need time to come to fruition, so does the Kingdom of God. That is why in the Lord’s Prayer, we pray, “thy kingdom come.” We know that it will come in its fullness at the end of time. All we need is faith.
