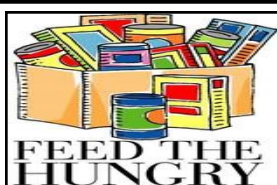
You may choose to show your face, or if you prefer, slides for each mystery can be shown while the Rosary is prayed.
