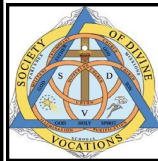

THE PATH TO HEAVEN

TODAY'S READINGS TELL US OF GOD'S GENEROSITY AND THE WAY TO HEAVEN. FOR MANY OF US, OUR FAITH JOURNEY BEGINS WHEN WE ARE TAUGHT TO LOVE



THE LORD EARLY IN OUR LIVES. BUT FOR SOME PEOPLE, THEIR FAITH DOES NOT COME UNTIL LATER IN THEIR LIVES,

COMPARE THIS TO TODAY'S PARABLE ABOUT WORKING IN THE VINEYARD: THE FIRST WORKERS HIRED BY THE LANDOWNER BEGAN WORKING EARLY IN THE DAY. AS THE DAY WENT BY, THE LANDLORD CONTINUED TO HIRE MORE WORKERS. WHEN THE DAY ENDED, THE LANDLORD (GOD) PAID EVERYONE THE SAME.

PAY THE LAST FIRST AND THE FIRST LAST. WHY? BECAUSE EVERYONE DESIRES GOD'S LOVE. GOD GIVES HIS LOVE, *ALL OF HIS LOVE*, TO EVERYONE WITHOUT EXCEPTION, BUT THEY MUST OPEN THEMSELVES UP TO THIS LOVE.

THE LIFELONG DISCIPLES OF JESUS - THE WORKERS WHO STARTED EARLY IN THE DAY - MUST HAVE FAITH THAT GOD KNOWS THEY HAVE WORKED HARD FOR JESUS THROUGHOUT THEIR LIVES. THEY MUST NOT BE ENVIOUS OF THOSE WHO WORKED JUST A SHORT TIME AFTER FINALLY FINDING GOD.

THE NEEDS OF THOSE WHO FIND GOD LATE ARE NOT ANY LESS THAN THOSE WHO FOUND

GOD EARLY IN THEIR LIVES. BEING A CHRISTIAN DEMANDS WORK – FAITH. IT IS NOT A PASSIVE EXISTENCE, BUT RATHER AN ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN THE WORK OF GOD. SO IT DOES NOT MATTER IF THIS ACCEPTANCE OF GOD'S LOVE COMES EARLY OR LATE IN LIFE BECAUSE THIS LOVE CAN NEVER BE EARNED, ONLY ACCEPTED.

FAITH, HUMILITY AND LOVE. SO HOW BIG IS YOUR NEED FOR GOD TODAY? CAN YOU SHARE THIS LOVE FROM GOD? YES, THAT IS OUR MISSION. THAT IS OUR PATH TO HEAVEN.

Christ Our Hope: Building A Vibrant Church

“He that giveth unto the poor shall not lack: but he that hideth his eyes shall have many a curse.”

God calls us to support the most vulnerable among us and the *Christ Our Hope: Building a Vibrant Church* campaign offers us the opportunity to do that. A portion of the dollars raised will fund an endowment for Catholic Charities so it may expand its ability to serve the needy. This is a pressing need because right now

Catholic Charities is not able to serve - on average 70 families or 280 people - per month. Beyond that need, the campaign offers great hope at home here at Mater Dei Parish. Sixty cents of every dollar will come back to us so we may address our many needs, such as the roof and church windows at St. Mary's, the sound system and choir loft at St. Edward's, the church windows and parking lot at St. James, and the parking lot at St. Benedict's.

While considering your gift, it's worth remembering that a key provision of the CARES Act states that a donor may deduct 100% of any gift to a qualified charity against their 2020 adjusted gross income. Please note that this deduction expires at the end of 2020.

A volunteer from our parish will be calling you to discuss the campaign and answer any questions you may have. Please be receptive to their call and take time to talk to them. Remember that these are your fellow parishioners, neighbors, friends, your brothers and sisters in Christ. They are serving God in their volunteer role.
