St. James Monthly Information Meeting was held on May 17th at 6:00 pm via Zoom

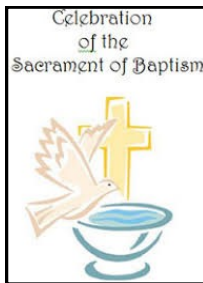


- Plans are underway for St. James' 150th Anniversary Celebration on Sunday, July 25th

### NEWS FROM ST. MARY'S

ST. MARY'S HELD THEIR MONTHLY INFORMATIONAL MEETING ON MAY 10TH AT 6:00 PM VIA ZOOM.



- COORDINATORS ARE REQUIRED TO REPORT FOR MASS EARLY TO SET UP PRIOR TO THE ROSARY.
- SIGN-IN IS NO LONGER REQUIRED AT MASS. HOWEVER, THE TABLE NEEDS TO BE KEPT CLEAN AND HANDOUTS SHOULD BE PLACED ON THE ENTRANCE TABLE. THOSE WHO ARE NOT VACCINATED ARE ENCOURAGED TO CONTINUE WEARING FACE MASKS. MAXIMUM CAPACITY REMAINS AT 250 PER MASS.
- EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS ARE NEEDED FOR WEEKEND MASSES - AVAILABLE EMS SHOULD INFORM THE MASS COORDINATOR THAT THEY ARE AVAILABLE TO HELP.
- LITURGICAL NOTES:
  - + LECTORS & EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS ARE ASKED NOT TO DO DOUBLE DUTY
  - + VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED TO SERVE AS LECTORS, EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS AND MASS COORDINATORS
  - + PASCHAL CANDLE MUST BE LIT AT DAILY & WEEKEND MASSES UNTIL PENTECOST SUNDAY ON MAY 23RD
  - + MAY 22ND: CONFIRMATION AT 1:00 PM – 30 BEING CONFIRMED. ATTENDANCE LIMITED TO SPONSOR AND 4 FAMILY MEMBERS. CHURCH WILL NEED TO BE CLEANED AFTERWARD.
  - + MAY 22ND–JUNE 4TH - OUR LADY OF FATIMA STATUE WILL BE TRAVELING THROUGH ST. JAMES (MAY 22-28), ST. BENEDICT (MAY 28) & ST. EDWARD (MAY 28-JUNE 4)

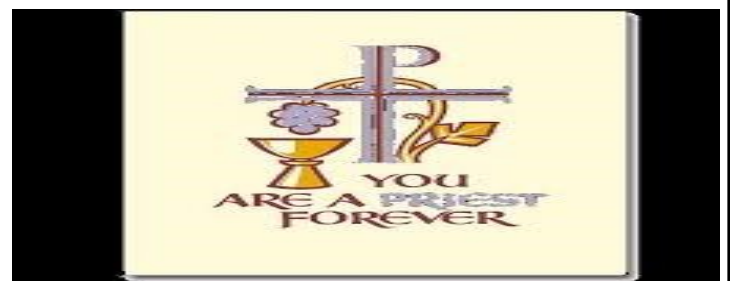
