 - * Bob Fisher will check church storage for old-style vestments and, if available, will impersonate a priest from long ago.

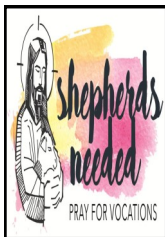

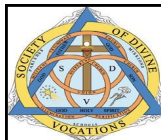
