Mission of Love and Peace

God sent the prophet Amos to the land of Judah with a mission to prophesy there. He was sent to announce the ways of peace and



blessing. Amos was instructed to take nothing with him, but to earn his bread while there.


Jesus also sent His disciples on a mission, sharing similar instructions. Their mission was as equally prophetic as that of the Old Testament prophets sent by God. The disciples were sent to announce peace and to liberate people from the bondage of sin and sickness. Jesus entrusted them with authority to cleanse the Gentile world of the control of evil spirits and all kinds of oppressions. They were reminded of the power of the Word of God that would be unleashed in their preaching. The disciples set out on their mission trusting in God's care rather than relying on themselves to meet their needs.

As disciples today, our strength also comes from God. That is the right start. God meets our every need as we wholeheartedly serve Christ and His Kingdom. To be a disciple is to be a prophet. We do not need to worry when we are not welcomed and the Gospel is rejected. Our responsibility is to share the Gospel faithfully and tirelessly.

St. Paul reminds us of the immensity of the spiritual blessing we have received and the nobility of our call to be His beloved children. He sends us today with a specific mission..."to be holy and blameless before God and the world in love".

Totus Tuus is Coming to Mater Dei Parish this Month

Totus Tuus is a one week long program with a session for grades 1-8 during the day and a session for high school students



each evening. The activities combine catechesis, evangelization, Christian witness and worship with games, talks and loads of fun to lead young people to a deeper relationship with Christ.

Mater Dei's Totus Tuus program for grades 1 -8 will be at St. Edward's Parish Hall from July 26th to July 30th from 9 am - 3 pm. The cost is \$60 per student. Snacks will be provided, but each child should bring a lunch.

Mater Dei's Totus Tuus high school program will be at St. Mary's from July 25th - July 29th from 7 pm - 9 pm and will include games, prayer, talks, snacks and an evening of Adoration. The cost is \$25 per family.

There is a maximum cost of \$150 per family and scholarships are available through the parish.
